BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Houghton is Western Australia's most awarded winery. Established in 1836, and is the third oldest winery in Australia.

Houghton sources the finest fruit from vineyards in all premium viticultural areas across Western Australia, to craft exceptional wines that truly reflect their regional origins.

TASTING NOTES

Light straw in colour, this wine displays complex, clean, fresh, tropical fruit aromas with notes of melon and peach.

The full flavoured, rich palate shows wonderful fruit flavours of melon and tropical fruit. With a soft acid and long, silky finish, this wine is ideal either as an accompaniment to food or a refreshing drink on its own.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The juice was fermented cool to retain the freshness and fruity character, and after fermentation the resultant wines were prepared with minimal handling and fining prior to early bottling to retain all of the fine, fresh fruit flavours.

A wine to enjoy while young, fresh and vibrant, or it will gain complexity by careful cellaring over the next three years.
