## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Houghton is Western Australia's most awarded winery. Established in 1836, and is the third oldest winery in Australia.

Houghton sources the finest fruit from vineyards in all premium viticultural areas across Western Australia, to craft exceptional wines that truly reflect their regional origins.

## TASTING NOTES

This wine displays fresh fruit salad aromas with pronounced tropical and citrus fruit.

Pale straw in colour, this wine has a nose of melons and peach with just a touch of oak. The palate is soft, full flavoured and rich, with an abundance of fruit and supporting oak which gives the wine texture and flavour.

## WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Careful winemaking served to enhance the richness and complexity of the juice derived from these grapes, resulting in a wine that is eminently drinkable.

This wine can be enjoyed at any occasion while young or would benefit from short term cellaring, up to three years.
